Knowledge vs. Experience



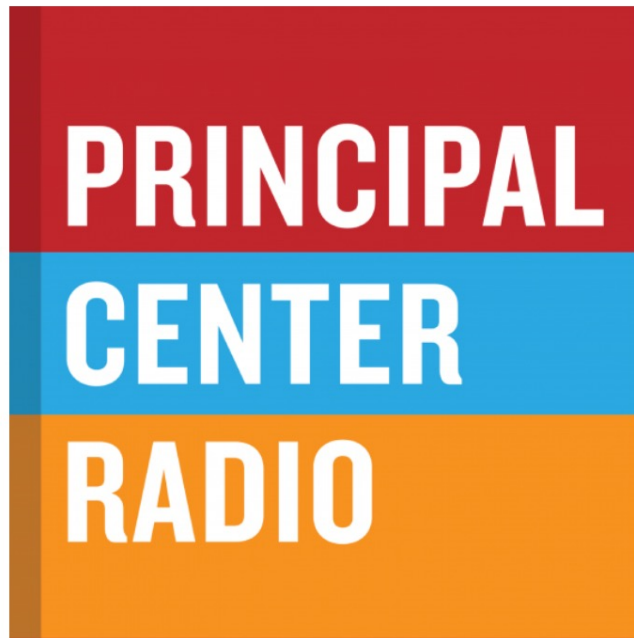
- Learning alone will not give you *accomplishments* to put on your résumé

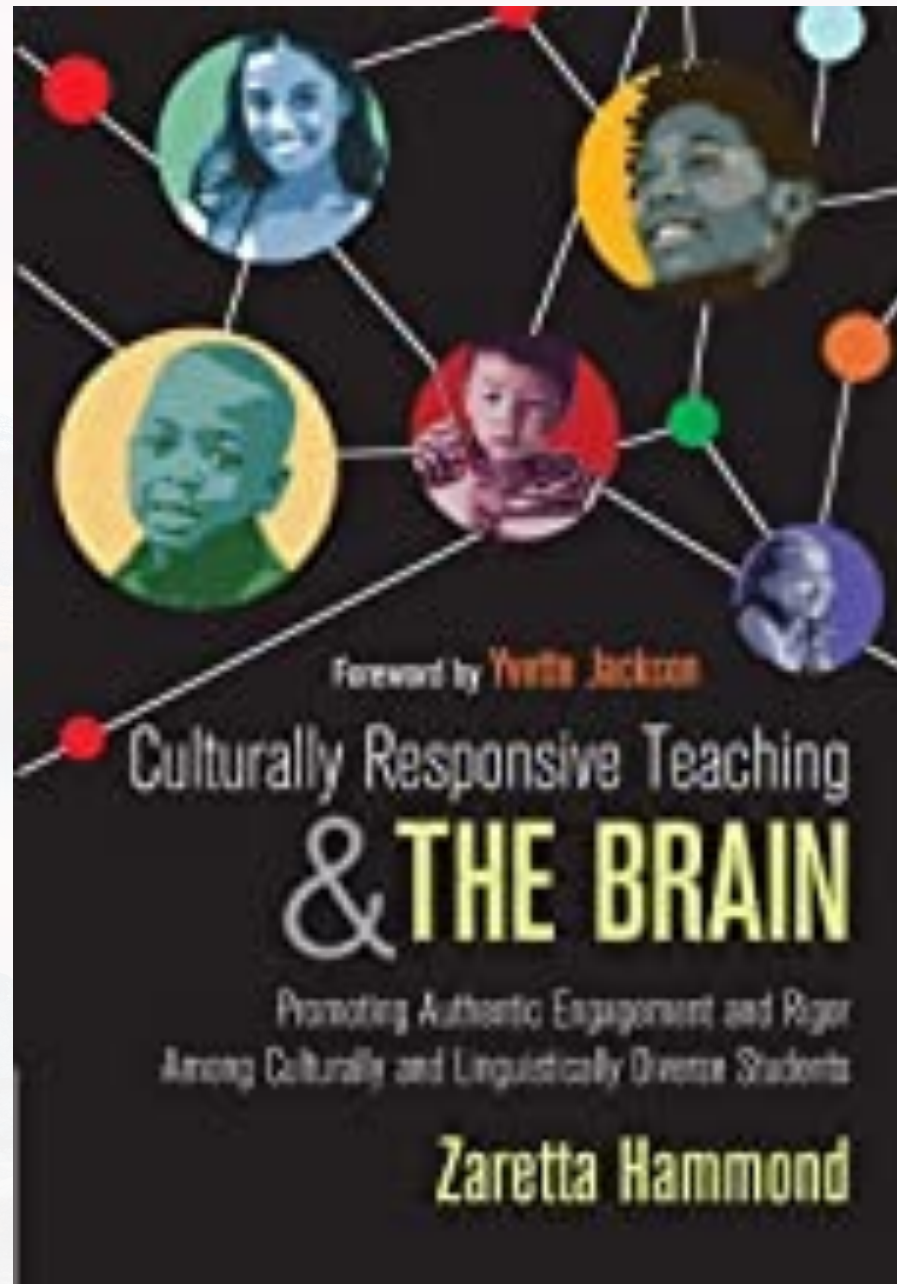

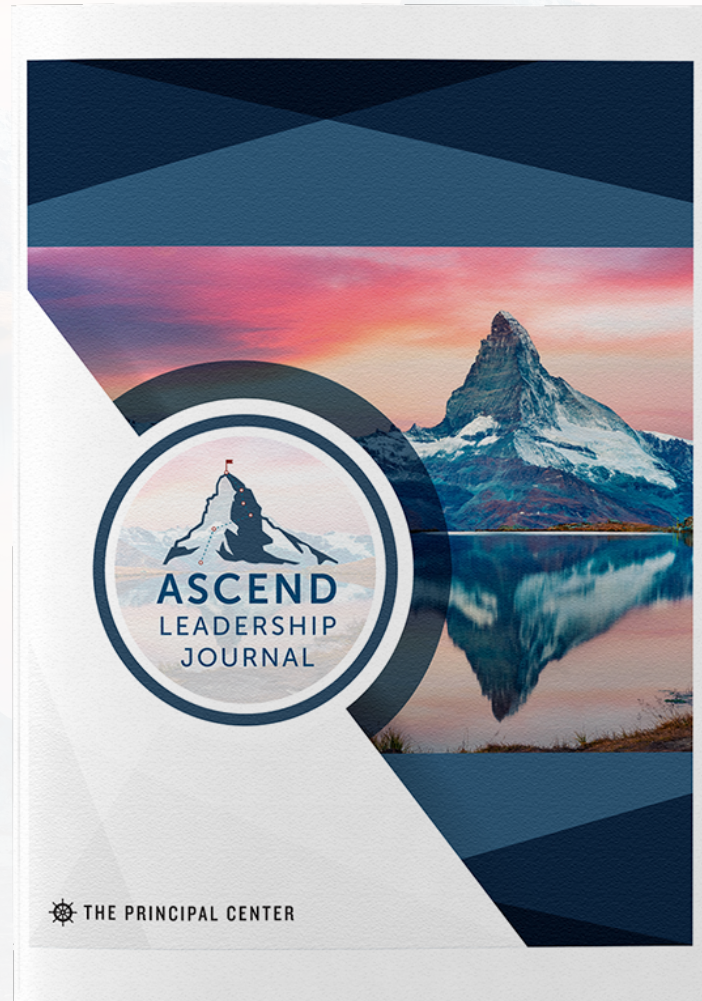
