Overview of Cycles 1-3



Cycle 1

 Every teacher you supervise  1-2 minute visits, back to back Notes Chat

Cycle 2

 3 a day  5-10 minutes each Notes Chat

Cycle 3

 3 a day  10-15 minutes each Notes Chat

Cycle 1

- Every teacher in one day
- 1-2 minutes each
- Smile and wave
- No notes, feedback, or discussion





Why Ramp Up Gradually?

1. Sustainability
2. Trust





Tips for Cycle 2



- Stay 5-10 minutes and pay attention
- Say something nice, but don't give feedback
- No device or notes
- Be "present and pleasant"

The Role of Enjoyment



- Classroom walkthroughs should be professionally rewarding for every one
- If you are miserable, it'll show
- If teachers are miserable, you'll get resistance
- If you enjoy the process, you'll stick with it

Cognitive Lift




- Strive to keep the cognitive lift of your walkthroughs light
- Don't force yourself to come up with feedback
- Don't give yourself homework
- Don't give the teacher homework



KEYS TO SUSTAINABLE IMPACT



1. Frequent
2. Brief
3. Substantive
4. Open-Ended
5. Evidence-Based
6. Criterion-Referenced
7. Conversation-Oriented



The Cycle 2 → Cycle 3 Transition



- Stay a bit longer
- Begin taking notes in 3rd cycle
- Get people used to your presence
- Give an experience of positive close attention
- Take notes on paper


