Why Start Now?



- The best time to start is the first day of school
- The second-best time is today
- Cycle 1 will be a little awkward no matter what
- It's equally easy any day of the school year

Cycle 1




- Every teacher in one day, 1-2 minutes each
- No notes or feedback conversation
- Smile & wave
- Be “present and pleasant”
- Be sure you get to everyone you supervise
- Optionally, visit all teachers in building

- What have I not noticed before?
- What should we think about shifting long-term?
